

What do I bring to Orientation?

If your household receives food stamps, bring:

- Birth certificate
- Utility bill
- Social security card
- Medical card (if applicable)
- Copy of current school year IEP (if applicable)
- If attending High School: bring transcript (ask your HS for an *unofficial* copy, it's free)
- If you graduated, bring your diploma
- Illinois driver license or IL State I.D.

If your household does **NOT** receive food stamps, bring:

- Birth certificate for **yourself** & **ALL** brothers & sisters in your household
- Utility bill
- Social security card
- Medical card (if applicable)
- Copy of current school year IEP (if applicable)
- If attending High School: bring transcript (ask your HS for an *unofficial* copy, it's free)
- If you graduated, bring your diploma
- Illinois driver's license or IL state I.D.
- Last pay check stub, unemployment check or social security benefits of **person supporting the household**

** If you are 17 years old or younger, your application **MUST** be signed by at least one parent or your legal guardian.*

*** Your application is **not** complete if documentation is missing. Please come prepared. We'll make copies.*
